In accordance with current Government and Diocesan advice it is with regret that the decision had to be made to cancel all planned celebrations of First Holy Communion and Confirmations in the parish. Present advice is that these ceremonies should not be rescheduled for the coming weeks. Further advice will follow when these ceremonies can be rescheduled.
