OIDHREACHT AN CHLÁIR - CANON MICHAEL McLAUGHLIN: The next video interview from our Community Memories project, funded by the Heritage Council, will be shown in The Malbay, Miltown Malbay on Monday, April 15th at 8.00pm. Canon Michael McLaughlin (interviewed by Séamus Mac Mathúna) talks of his Donegal parents, his father a Garda stationed in Miltown from the early days of the State, and the family's visits North during WWII. He describes, with many memorable anecdotes, the daily life and duties of the Garda, the landing of a Canadian pilot's plane during the war, the shops in Church St, school life, football and hurling street games, the circus, the Parochial Hall as a social centre, playing with Clonbony, and training the champion Miltown team of 1959. He looks back on his service as a priest in many locations and particularly Kilmaley, where he has spent the past 25 years and where he participated in a major community housing development which he sees as a model of rural community initiative.
