In his writings he reminds us; "The fundamental consecration of every Christian ordained or not, is Baptism.....Every other dignity and service in the Church arises out of this fundamental consecration." His most recent book is "Priesthood of the Faithful; Key to a Living Church" This seminar would be of interest to anybody striving to understand more deeply the mission of all the baptised in the modern world and today's Church.
