CONNOLLY COMMUNITY PLANNING: Clare Local Development Group (CLDC) has included Connolly in a community planning programme, which gives an opportunity for everyone in the community to say what they would like to see developed in Connolly over the next few years. The process includes a survey of the broader community in and around Connolly to find out what people think about Connolly – what you like about it, and what you think could be improved. A plan will then be developed based on the results of this survey. CLDC will hold a Public Meeting in Connolly National School at 8.00pm on Wednesday the 20th of March to provide information on the planning process and to discuss what needs to be in the survey. The plan will be very useful for funding applications to LEADER or any other rural development funding as it will be community led, based on evidence of community need and will be realistic in its action.

COMMUNITY LED LITURGY WHAT IS COMMUNITY LED LITURGY

Why is it being introduced? We need to prepare now for the changes that lie ahead for our parishes and Christian Communities. With declining numbers of priests, we need to ensure that that each parish and Christian Community is resourced 'to assemble its members, proclaim the Gospel and pray as a Community'. This means training lay people to lead liturgical celebrations on Sundays and weekdays when the need arises. People are already being trained for this ministry in many parts of our diocese.

WHY ARE WE DOING THIS WHEN THERE ARE STILL SO MANY PRIESTS

We are blessed at present to have so many priests still ministering in our parishes. But the reality we must face is that we no longer have priests to replace those who leave a parish through illness or death. Some parishes in our diocese are sharing priests and this will become more and more a reality as time goes on.

BUT I THOUGHT ONLY A PRIEST COULD LEAD THE LITURGY?

Only a priest can lead the celebration of the Eucharist but in circumstances where a priest is unavailable to preside at the Eucharist, a Community Led Liturgy of the Word with Holy Communion may be led by lay people who have been trained and authorised by the Diocese to do so.

We extend an invitation and are looking for people to become involved in this very important ministry and training so as to enable our Christian community to meet and pray. Anyone interested and willing to be involved please give your names to Fr. Pat
