**HISTORY IN THE MAKING:** One hundred and thirty seven years ago a herdsman from the townland of Dromdoolaghty in Knockanean, Doora was murdered as he was on his way home from Sunday mass at the Franciscan Friary in Ennis. Another local man Francie Hynes, known to the murdered man was charged with the murder and executed in September 1882. A great granddaughter of the murdered man Catherine Delahunty living in New Zea-

land and well on in years has written a book on the story. The book will be launched in the Grove Bar, Roslevan on Tuesday night 9<sup>th</sup> of July at 9.00pm by Dr Ciaran O'Murchada.
