Confirmation 2023

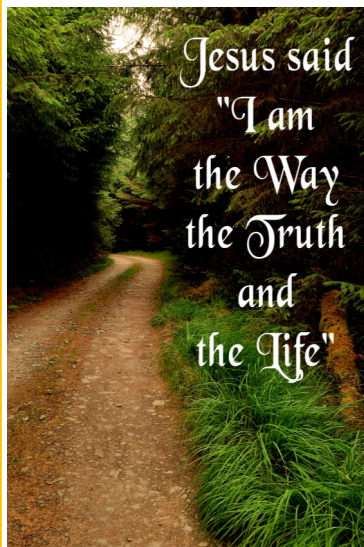
