COMMUNITY FUND: A community fund of €14,000 from the Letteragh wind farm is being made available to the Kilmaley parish on an annual basis. Kilmaley-Meitheal is responsible for its distribution to active community organisations within the parish. Each year the money will be targeted towards a specific parish area as follows, Year 1- Connolly, Year 2 - Lisroe, Year 3 -Inch, Year 4-Kilmaley. It is envisaged that this rotation will continue into the future for 15 years. Criteria to draw down the funding dictate that it must go towards a capital investment project that benefits the greatest amount of people possible within the area. It cannot be used to fund day to day operational costs of any organisation. Kilmaley Meitheal is now inviting proposals for capital funding from organisations within the Connolly area. The proposal must include the following, 1. Description of the capital project proposal and its need within the community. 2, Details of who it will benefit 3. Full costs of the project including the availability of additional funding if required to complete the project.
